Short Description	
<p>The course focuses on central social, cultural and political issues of the Palestinians since the late Ottoman period to the present. We will deal with the process of integration of the Palestinian as a social and political community, and discuss the formation of the distinct Palestinian identity. We shall also discuss the challenges and fundamental issues of Palestinian society during the Mandate period and examine the key processes experienced by it after the wars of 1948 and 1967 and following the establishment of the Palestinian Authority in 1994. We will conclude with examination of the central dilemmas that occupies the Palestinians today. The course will combine short clips and films.</p>
